
Rally goers spoke about national security, including concerns over Congressional inaction and support for Ukraine.

The Strategic Planning Committee met in March to develop a plan for the continual growth and development of the Susquehanna County Democratic Party. After discussion and consensus, the committee agreed upon the following goals for 2025 and beyond.

One Year Goals:

- 1. Focus on local elections in 2025, fill open positions with candidates
- 2. Maintain our public presence-

 - B) The effects of the Republican agenda on local voters
- 3. Motivate and engage young people into voting, volunteering, and/or running for office

2027 County Elections


